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QUICK INSTALLATION & CONFIGURATION GUIDE

The ITSV-3 is a product developed for Zenitel Norway AS and is primarily used as part of a Zenitel Norway AS IP Intercom solution. The ITSV-3 is not pre-configured to support or carry emergency calls to any type of hospital, law enforcement agency, medical care unit ("Emergency Service(s)") or any other kind of Emergency Service. You must make additional arrangements to access Emergency Services. It is your responsibility to purchase SIP-compliant Internet telephone service, properly configure the ITSV-3 to use that service, and periodically test your configuration to confirm that it works as you expect. If you do not do so, it is your responsibility to purchase traditional wireless or landline telephone services to access Emergency Services.

## Overview

• ITSV-3 Touch Station with Video (Item Number: 1490003010)

The ITSV-3 features a 7" 1024x600 capacitive touch screen TFT LCD, megapixel camera, dual Gigabit ports with PoE/PoE+, integrated WiFi (802.11a/b/g/n) & Bluetooth, rich peripheral interfaces, and Android 7.0. The ITSV-3 delivers HD audio & video, leading edge SIP intercom features and integration with IC-EDGE and ICX-AlphaCom IP Intercom Platforms developed by Zenitel Norway AS. ITSV-3 redefines the desktop communication experience with a raised level of innovation and integration of state-of-the-art real-time video conferencing, and personalized rich media presentation & delivery.

### **Phone Setup**



#### Installing the Phone with Wall Mount

- 1. Attach the wall mount to the slots on the back of the phone.
- 2. Attach the phone to the wall via the wall mount hole.
- 3. Pull out the tab from the handset cradle (see figure below).
- 4. Rotate the tab and plug it back into the slot with the extension up to hold the handset while the phone is mounted on the wall.



### **Using the Phone Stand**

The ITSV-3 has a built-in phone stand. To use it, pull out the phone stand handle on the back of the phone. Adjust the angle as preferred and make sure the phone stands still on the desktop.



### **Connecting the Phone**

- 1. Connect the handset and main phone case with the phone cord.
- 2. Connect the LAN Port of the phone to the RJ45 socket of a hub/switch or a router (LAN side of the router) using the Ethernet cable.
- Connect the 12V DC output plug to the Power jack on the phone and plug the power adapter into an electrical outlet. If PoE switch is used in step 2, this step could be skipped.
- 4. The LCD will display booting up or firmware upgrading information. Before continuing, please wait for the main screen display to appear.
- 5. Using the web configuration interface or the menu of the touch screen, you can further configure network connection using static IP, DHCP, etc.

### **Configuring the ITSV-3 Using Touch Screen**

- 1. Make sure the phone is properly powered up, in idle screen mode and connected to the network.
- Select Settings > Advanced > Account settings. Tap on one of the Accounts to configure Account name, SIP server (ICX-AlphaCom or IC-EDGE), SIP user ID (Extension Number), SIP authentication ID (if required) and SIP authentication password (if required).

**Note**: For changes to take immediate effect, it may be necessary to temporarily disable the account. Do this by setting **Account activation** to **OFF** and tapping **OK**. Then reenable your account by setting **Account activation** to **ON** and tapping **OK**.

- Follow the LCD menu options to configure other settings on the phone. For example, to configure static IP on the ITSV-3, set up static IP address via menu Settings > Network > Ethernet settings.
- 4. If you want to see your accounts on your home screen, return to the home screen (press the **Home** button). Press the **Menu** button, and select **Widgets**. Several account display widgets will appear. Select and drag the widget to the home screen.



#### Configuring the ITSV-3 Using Web Browser

- 1. Ensure your phone is properly powered up and connected to the Internet.
- To find the IP address of the ITSV-3, use the touch screen and tap Settings > Status > Network status > IPv4 address
- 3. Enter the phone's IP address in your PC's browser.
- 4. Log in by entering the default username / password: admin / alphaadmin

- 5. To register an account on the ITSV-3:
  - Select Account > Account 1/2/3/4/5/6... > General Settings
- Set Account Name, SIP Server (ICX-AlphaCom or IC-EDGE), SIP User ID (Directory Number), SIP Authentication ID (if required) and SIP Authentication Password (if required).

Once this is done, re-enable the account by checking the box for **Account Active** followed by **Save** and **Apply** again.
